

GLOVE BOX GUIDE

In the event of an accident

1. Notify police immediately if the other driver (s):

- Refuse to stop
- Refuses to exchange details
- Appears to be under the influence of alcohol or drugs

Also notify the police if:

- Someone is fatally injured or requires medical attention;
- Any vehicle involved needs to be towed away;
- Required by law

2. Write down vital details immediately on the Accidental Details Form - this will include the information you need to collect

3. Don't admit fault—just state the facts.

Protect your legal rights—don't say the accident is your fault. Of course you should state the true facts of the accident in any statements, but law does not require you to admit fault. (Admission of liability may result in your claim being denied)
